### Year 9 Setting Information - September 2011

Your daughter has been given her new timetable which shows which classes she is in this year. This letter is intended to clarify what some of the codes on that timetable mean, and to allow you to see how the students have been grouped. Any changes to sets from Year 8 have been made on an evaluation of progress during the academic year and a set change may have been made to enable them to make greater progress this year

In Year 9, for most classes students are taught in sets. The number next to the subject code on the timetable tells you which set your daughter is in (1 is the highest set). So your daughter will be in classes with students who have similar ability to her.
