Equipment list

The well-organised and well-equipped student should make sure that s/he has the following useful items!

- ✓ One ring binder file for each subject (for starters, this number will grow over the two years!)
- ✓ One ring binder 'working' file for carrying backwards and forwards to school
- ✓ Several sets of file dividers
- ✓ A refill pad of file paper - wide lined for most subjects, narrow lined or squared for maths
- ✓ Ruler
- ✓ HB pencils
- ✓ Pens - ballpoint packs of 10 are ideal
- ✓ Highlighters
- ✓ Eraser
- ✓ Ruler
- ✓ A pack of pencil crayons
- ✓ A pack of project covers]- for handing in work
- ✓ Plastic wallets]
- ✓ A USB pen drive
- ✓ School planner (provided)
